Established in 1994, the City of Homestead Community Redevelopment Agency (CRA) has worked to reinvest local dollars to combat neighborhood deterioration and eliminate economic blight within the redevelopment area.

This reinvestment can take the form of public infrastructure, residential and commercial rehabilitation and development, community policing and enhanced code enforcement, placemaking, historic preservation, and more.

Streetscape & Utility Replacement



Starting in 2026, the CRA and City will launch a utility and streetscape upgrade in historic downtown to support redevelopment and enhance safety and aesthetics.

Commercial Rehabilitation



Opening in 2025, *Sak Pase*, investing more than \$1M, with a \$75K grant, to renovate a vacant building for its second South Florida restaurant.

Triangle Mixed-Use Redevelopment



The CRA cleared multiple unsafe properties for the Triangle Project, a mixed-use, mixed-income, transit-oriented development, and secured a \$783,400 federal grant for site cleanup.

Homestead Station



The CRA helped to develop *Homestead Station*, a vibrant complex with retail, entertainment, dining, and parking, next to Miami-Dade's BRT route.

Historic Seminole Theater



After 40 years of vacancy, the 1921 landmark was donated to the City, with the CRA leading its restoration into a state-of-the-art performance facility.

Losner Park



The CRA and City transformed an underused park into a vibrant hub with a playground, stage, Veterans' Memorial, and event space.
