• RESIDENTIAL CHECKLIST • TEMPORARY SERVICE

THE CITY OF HOMESTEAD PROVIDES PROPERTY OWNERS, REAL ESTATE BROKERS, AND REALTORS WITH THE ABILITY TO REQUEST TEMPORARY ELECTRIC AND WATER SERVICES ONCE PER YEAR FOR UP TO 30 DAYS. THIS SERVICE IS ONLY APPLICABLE TO RESIDENTIAL PROPERTIES.

DOCUMENTS NEEDED:

- Copy of valid government issued ID (State Issued Driver License or Passport Book)
- City of Homestead Business Tax Receipt

- Letter of Authorization from Property Owners (Real Estate Brokers and Agents)

MAKING A REQUEST ONLINE:

1. Visit www.homesteadfl.gov/startstop
2. Click on Utilities Customer Service
3. Select Residential and choose "Yes" for Temporary Service
4. Complete the application and pay a \$25 connection fee
5. Customer Service team reviews application within 24 hours and will follow up with your customer account details or request additional information to complete your request. Note: Email correspondence will be sent from customerservicequestions@homesteadfl.gov.

MAKING A REQUEST IN-PERSON:

1. Visit us at City of Homestead City Hall, 100 Civic Court, Homestead, FL 33030.
2. Be sure to have all required documentation with you when you visit us.

PUBLIC SAFETY INSPECTION:

A safety inspection will be required for properties within the City of Homestead if the property has not had electric service within the last 12 months.

IMPORTANT TO NOTE:

Services will automatically be disconnected on the 30th day.
